RELEASE OF AGED CARE ROYAL COMMISSION FINAL REPORT 2021.

Released 26/02/2021. 148 recommendations for care, dignity and respect.

Overview of the report:

This report affects all operators of age care, community care and disability. Long standing problems on a mass scale are addressed and will require many changes to work practices, staffing and pay increases for carers and nurses. The federal Government must provide funding to achieve these changes. Certificate III will be **compulsory** for **all** care workers in all care sectors!

We are now finding that there is a huge demand for new qualified carers and nurses. The demand is growing daily and we need to train and retrain more care workers than ever.

Norgrove Expanded business for 2021

The SA Government has funded Norgrove and its clients to provide training for:

- 30 places for an Entry Level Unit Cluster for new workers gaining a partial qualifications of 7 units.
- 28 Traineeships places for new workers for Certificate III in individual support for one of our client partners.
- Assisting 125 Certificate III students with funding to gain their First Aid, accredited Manual Handling & CPR requirements for student placement as well as Unit BSBWOR301 Organise personal work priorities and development.
- Project funding for HLTAAP001 Recognise healthy body systems and HLTHPS006 Assist clients with medications for one of our client partners
- Project funding for First Aid certificates for 80 workers over 8 months for one of our client partners.

The above funded training is in addition to our normal Certificate III monthly intakes which have continued during COVID 19 and beyond. As well as our current Fee for Service manual handling, CPR and First aid courses, which all continue to grow with our clients demands

We are working closely with the Department of Innovation and Skills to provide high quality training which leads to paid jobs with our client partners, who are extremely supportive.

Norgrove is increasing its presence in Adelaide and surrounding suburbs to provide even more job opportunities for students.

We ask that you provide us with any feedback from your worksite or your network to assist others to be trained.

Likewise, organisations can upskill their existing workforce using funded training places through Norgrove and its existing current contracts.
